Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp: Private Day Trip from Berlin - Tour Time 09:50am

Explore Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp on this private day trip from Berlin to one of the infamous Nazi concentration camps, a training site for camp staff as well as an experimental site located in Oranienburg, just forty-five minutes from Germany's capital. On your private tour you will:

- *Travel by train from Central Berlin with your expert guide to experience an immersive historical tour.
- *Tour the remains of the camp, the barracks, the museum exhibits, and the burial ground.
- *Learn how this former concentration camp was used during the Third Reich for political, ethnic, and religious prisoners.
- *Hear about the hardships that prisoners faced at the camp, and the appalling methods and experiments conducted on prisoners to formulate a perfect Aryan race.
- *Hear how the Soviets adopted the camp after the War to house 60,000 political prisoners.
- *Pay your respects at the "National Memorial" inside the camp.

The Sachsenhausen concentration camp was built in 1936 by internees from other camps and was the first to be built under the New Chief of Police, the infamous SS Leader Heinrich Himmler.

It was designed to be the standard for other camps - both in its escape-proof layout, and its abusive treatment of prisoners with over 200,000 people imprisoned there between 1936-45. At first, prisoners included opponents of the Nazis, and later it received Jews, Sinti and Roma, homosexuals, and anti-socials.

Thousands of prisoners died in Sachsenhausen concentration camps as a result of disease, forced labor, hunger, brutal medical experiments, mistreatment, and torture, or were the victims of systematic extermination by the SS troops.

You will tour the camp and see the entrance called Tower A; later your guide will show you the extermination unit and crematorium built in 1943, chillingly dubbed Station Z by the SS guards.

You will learn about the appalling treatment of prisoners, the experiments and torture conducted on them, and the shocking Sachsenhausen salute, the death strip, and the shoe running detail where prisoners were forced to march around a parade ground for days, with full backpacks, in order to test the durability of various boot soles.

After a very emotional tour, you will be able to pay your respects at the National Memorial created in 1961 inside the camp, before returning to Berlin.

Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp Regulations:

- *Avoid group interactions that are not in keeping with a commemorative site.
- *Do not smoke.
- *Do not use flash photography or any other light source.
- *Do not touch any relics or objects. They are of irreplaceable value.
- *Visitors are liable for any damage that they cause.
- *It is not advisable for children under the age of 12 to visit the Memorial site, the museums, and the former crematoriums.

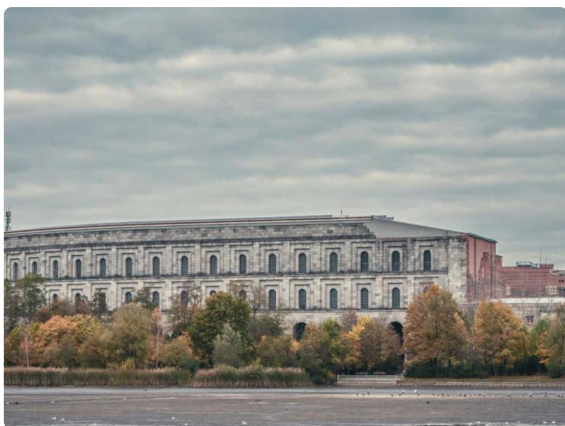

Private Nuremberg History Tour with English-Speaking Driving Guide - 4 Hours - 10:00am

After being met by your driving guide at your hotel, make the short drive to the former Nazi Party Rally Grounds. Here, Hitler held several assemblies between 1933 and 1938 to glorify Nazism and inspire followers. For guests who have studied Hitler and seen images of him speaking, the Rally Grounds will be a familiar sight. You will also visit the World War II Documentation Center, also found at the Rally Grounds, which hosts a permanent exhibit titled 'Fascination and Terror' and examines the causes and consequences of the National Socialist German Workers' Party, or Nazi Party.

Continuing onward, you will stroll through the medieval city of Nuremberg to view some of its many highlights including the historic city center, Imperial Castle, the Johannis Cemetery, and the Palace of Justice where the Nuremberg trials were held between 1945 and 1949.

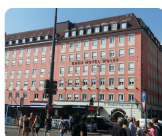
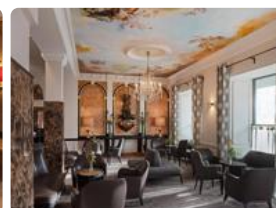

CENTRALLY AT THE MAIN TRAIN STATION IN MUNICH

Due to its central location at Munich Central Station, you can easily walk to Munich's old town and the city center in 15 minutes from the Eden Hotel Wolff. But if you don't want to explore Munich's sights on foot, you can also do so by S-Bahn, U-Bahn or tram, as all stops are in the immediate vicinity of the hotel. You can get to the exhibition center in 20 minutes with the U2 directly from the main train station, while the Lufthansa airport bus takes you to the airport within 45 minutes without stopping. Furthermore, our hotel garage and a public car park behind the hotel offer parking facilities for our guests. Shared Royal Castles Neuschwanstein and Linderhof Tour from Munich - 10.5 Hours - Tour 16 for: SKLAR/Stacy, SKLAR/Barry

Wander through the scenic German countryside on your way to Neuschwanstein Castle and Linderhof Royal Palace. Both were dreamed up and built by King Ludwig II and are known for their idyllic location and unique architecture.

You will first visit Linderhof Palace, a French rococo-style castle surrounded by immaculately manicured gardens, and then continue to Oberammergau. This charming village is known for the famous Passion Play and the traditional art of woodcarving.

After a quick stop you will arrive at idyllic Neuschwanstein Castle around midday, where you will have enough time to explore the castle, have lunch, and do some souvenir shopping.

Entrance tickets for Neuschwanstein Castle & Linderhof Palace must be purchased on the bus by credit card (30 EUR per person in 2023). The guide will arrange skip-the-line-tickets with guaranteed entrance and no waiting.

The tours at Neuschwanstein Castle and Linderhof Palace take approximately 30 minutes and will be carried out by the castle staff.

The walk up to Neuschwanstein Castle takes approximately 30 minutes. Alternatively, there are horse carriages or a shuttle bus. Neither can be reserved; costs are not included and need to be paid by the clients directly.

Horse carriages will stop 1476 feet beneath the castle; the walk uphill takes about 5-10 minutes. The shuttle bus will stop 1640 feet from the castle near lookout Marienbrcke; the walk downhill takes about 10-15 minutes.

Linderhof Palace is located 10-15 minutes by foot from the entrance.
